## Special Needs

Thalia Mara Hall is handicapped accessible. A special sound system (We must be notified in advance if this is needed.) and seating for persons with disabilities are available. A handicap drive and ramp are located on the west side of the building (right side if facing the theatre). An elevator is located on the ground floor of the building. Wheelchair seating is available at the back of the Orchestra level, with a friend seat located next to the wheelchair opening.

## Admission Policy

Theatre doors open 1 hour before the start time of the performance.

Lobby doors will be opened for seating approximately 30 minutes prior to performance start time.

**Latecomers will be seated at the discretion of Ballet Magnificat! and may be asked to remain at the back of the theatre until intermission.**

The first light will be Pascagoula Street, turn Left onto Pascagoula

Thalia Mara Hall will be the second building on the Right (water fountain in front)
